

Nordcham Hanoi comes back to children's hospital

On Friday 3 February, representatives from the Nordic Chamber of Commerce in Hanoi came back to National Pediatrics Hospital in Hanoi to donate a total of VND 20 million to five poor families with children fighting serious pediatric diseases such as blood cancer. The children aged between 4 and 8 years come from families living in rural areas, and have to come to Hanoi for treatment for shorter or longer periods.

On behalf of all members, Chairman, Thomas Frisenberg said that the members of Nordcham Hanoi hoped that the donation would help the families and be a positive event given the hardship that the families have to deal with on a daily basis.
